## GRANT OF EASEMENT

Said easement grant is specifically for the purpose of erecting, maintaining, repairing, rebuilding, removing and operating an advertising sign for what is commonly known as the Holiday Hills Motel and Restaurant. Said sign shall be in the same general location as the presently existing Holiday Hills Resort sign and shall have the same general dimensions as that of the presently existing sign.
